

Appendix A: Household Income of 1946 Congressional Districts

Median household incomes for 1949 are herein reported as arithmetic averages of the county, municipality, township, or census tract figures within each congressional district. In the case of sub-counties, the Census reported the amount for families and unrelated individuals. For counties or states, the report is for family incomes. The source is the 1950 Census.

The averages below do not take into account the varying numbers of the households in the geographic components. For example, the North Carolina 10th District included a county which had 78% of the District's households and a reported median family income of \$3180, and five other counties with incomes from \$1200 to \$2494. The average of the counties is \$2045. The average of the households is \$2480.

The method used for the following figures emphasizes the importance of the varying components of the district, which gives a better perception of the overall district.
